Well, needless to say, these are definitely different times than I think any of us could have predicted. It's very strange not seeing all of your smiling faces or hearing the crack of the bat or the general sounds of enjoyment from a ball well hit or a pitch well thrown.

An update on what's happening at the park. Per the Governor's executive order which took effect at midnight, we are not allowed to hold any activities for the next 30 days... 1. because we are considered recreational and 2. doing so would violate the no more than 10 people at a time on the property rule. So, what that means...the earliest we can get back to playing ball at the park is **Sat, April 25** and **NOT** Mon, March 30, like we had originally hoped.

If that order changes and we can start up sooner, we certainly will. We have been and will be actively working on game schedules, so we're ready to go when the ban to assemble is lifted.

All that said, a lot of this whole situation is out of anyone's control but will ultimately depend on the steps each one of us take to help stop the spread. We certainly dislike having to put everything on hold even longer than we thought, but also know it's the socially responsible thing to do right now.
