

COVID RULES FOR 2021 SEASON

1. Masks are required at all times on the property....NO EXCEPTIONS. If you cannot wear a mask for medical reasons, please either do not come to the park or remain in your car. Masks should be worn properly: covering the nose, mouth, and chin areas.
2. All bleachers are closed. Please bring your own chair or something to sit on.
3. The concession stand will not be operational to start the season. It may remain closed for the entirety. We will evaluate as the season progresses.
4. The playground is closed and will be cordoned off.
5. If you or any member of your family are experiencing Covid-like symptoms, please notify your coach or the park and stay at home.
6. Players should use their own helmet and bat. If you do not have these items, they can be provided to your coach by the park. Catchers should also use their own gear.
7. Players should also bring their own water bottle. We will not be providing water coolers in the dugouts. We will have drink machines with water, Gatorade, and soda for purchase.
8. Please observe social distancing rules and remain 6-10' apart from anyone not in your immediate household.
9. Coaches and umpires must wear masks at all times. All coaches and the scorekeeper should remain outside the dugout and may bring buckets to sit on. Only players should be in the dugout. If your team requires a dugout monitor, that person must wear a mask.
10. Players may choose to wear a mask while practicing or playing on the field but are not required to do so. While in the dugout, all players must have on a mask.
11. Each player is limited to having their immediate family present during practices and games. Each family will be expected to socially distance together and remain at least 6' apart from other families.
12. Pickup games on empty fields are not allowed.
13. The park is not fully open to the general public. You must have a child who is registered at the park with a scheduled game or practice to be on the premises.
14. When games and practices are over, please leave the park. Do not hang around talking.
15. There will not be an all-star season.
16. We will not be hosting any post season tournaments.

We are very hopeful for a successful season with your cooperation in following the aforementioned rules. We understand that our rules are limiting, but feel they are what's necessary to reopen. We will continually evaluate our policies and make adjustments where necessary as state and local regulations change.
