

UPDATED COVID RULES AS OF JUNE 1, 2021

1. Masks are required at all times on the property for adults and anyone aged 12-18 who are not yet fully vaccinated, per CDC guidelines.
2. There are limited available bleachers at each field for use but please feel free to continue to bring your own chair or something to sit on.
3. The concession stand will open on Saturday, June 5 and will continue to be open through the remainder of the season on days with games. If there are no games on a particular day, the concession stand will be closed.
4. The playground is open for use.
5. If you or any member of your family are experiencing Covid-like symptoms, please notify your coach or the park and stay at home.
6. Players should still use their own helmet and bat. If you do not have these items, they can be provided to your coach by the park. Catchers should also use their own gear.
7. Players should also continue to bring their own water bottle. We will not be providing water coolers in the dugouts. We have drink machines with water, Gatorade, and soda for purchase.
8. Coaches and umpires who are not fully vaccinated must wear a mask at all times. All coaches and the scorekeeper should continue to remain outside the dugout and may bring buckets to sit on. Only players should be in the dugout. If your team requires a dugout monitor, that person must wear a mask if not fully vaccinated.
9. Players may choose to wear a mask while practicing or playing on the field and in the dugouts but are not required to do so.
10. The park is now fully open to the general public.
11. There will not be an all-star season.
12. We will not be hosting any post season tournaments.
